

TRAIL/GREENWAY PROJECTS

COVINGTON ROAD TRAIL

Project Description

Project Overview

This project is located along Covington Road in west central Fort Wayne, IN. The project consists of a new 10' wide asphalt multi-use trail running approximately 3.5 miles from Covington Road's intersection with Interstate 69 west to West Hamilton Road.

This project is partially funded by a TE Grant and is reviewed and administered by the Indiana Department of Transportation.

Transportation Improvements and Approximate Design Cost

The approximate construction cost of the completed project is estimated to be \$2,000,000, while the surveying, engineering,

environmental, and landscaping design cost is estimated at \$225,000.




Aerial Photograph of the Project Corridor

Project Design Responsibilities

DABEC is the prime engineering consultant for this project. Environmental documentation and permitting is subcontracted to JF New, while Trail Landscaping and Amenity design is being subcontracted to Lehman and Lehman, Inc. DABEC is reponsible directly for surveying, trail design, R/W determinations, floodway permitting, storm sewer design, and construction cost estimates.

Site Constraints

This section of Covington Road is very congested and carries with it difficult topographical constraints. In addition to tight Right-of-Way issues, the Covington Road corridor is quite steep in many places and is crossing two streams, with delineated wetlands lying along the planned path for the trail.
